Subject: Support for the Municipality of Brighton - Draven Alert

Recommendation:

That Council of the Township of South Stormont supports the Municipality of Brighton's resolution requesting changes to the Amber Alert system to allow for the creation a new alert called the Draven Alert, which will protect vulnerable children who have not been abducted but are at high risk of danger, injury or death and alert the public that they are missing.

Executive Summary & Background:

The Municipality of Brighton has requested endorsement and support of their resolution from all municipalities in Ontario related to the request for the addition of the Draven Alert to the Amber Alert system. The addition of the Draven Alert will allow for law enforcement to send out an alert for vulnerable children who go missing under circumstances that do not involve an abduction but are at serious risk of injury or death. The Municipality of Brighton's resolution is attached.
