Subject: By-law No. 2022-056 Advanced Voting and Reduced

Hours at Retirement Homes

Recommendation:

That By-law No. 2022-056, being a by-law to repeal By-law No. 2022-030 and to establish advanced voting and reduced hours of voting in a retirement home for the 2022 Municipal Elections be read and passed in open Council, signed and sealed this 13th day of July, 2022.

Executive Summary:

On April 27, 2022, Council adopted By-law No. 2022-030, establishing advance vote and reduced hours of voting in a retirement residence. Upon further investigation, it was identified that a voting place shall be provided on voting day for residents of a retirement home. The existing by-law provides for voting during the advance vote, not on voting day. As such, an additional hour of support has been added for Election Day, October 24, 2022, for the Woodland Villa Long Term Care Facility.

Background:

Sections 45 and 46 of the *Municipal Elections Act* requires that voting places be provided at retirement homes and institutions where, on nomination day, 20 or more beds are occupied by persons who are disabled, chronically ill or infirm, and further, that Council may pass a bylaw that the voting place(s) are only for the use of the residents of the institutions and providing for reduced opening hours.

Following consultation with the staff at the Woodland Villa Long Term Care Facility and Sunset Cove Retirement Home, advanced vote dates and times are confirmed as follows:

Woodland Villa Long Term Care Facility:
October 20, 2022 from 10 AM to 12 Noon; and
October 24, 2022 from 8:30 am to 9:30 am (if required)

Sunset Cove Retirement Residence: October 20, 2022 from 1:30 pm to 3:30 pm.
