THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH STORMONT

BY-LAW NO. 2023-036

- <u>BEING</u> a by-law to authorize a Boundary Roads Agreement between the Township of South Stormont and the Township of South Dundas.
- <u>WHEREAS</u> the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25, s. 5 (1) provides that the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its council;
- <u>AND WHEREAS</u> the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25, s. 5 (3) provides that the powers of every council are to be exercised by by-law;
- AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act 2001*, S.O. 2001. C. 25, s. 29 provides that the local municipalities on either side of a boundary line between municipalities have joint jurisdiction over any highways forming the boundary line;
- AND WHEREAS the Township of South Stormont is desirous of entering into an Agreement with the Township of purpose South Dundas for the of exchanging regarding road services maintenance, winter maintenance, and garbage pick-up in the locations described in "Schedule A".
- <u>NOW THEREFORE</u> Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Stormont enacts as follows:
  - 1. That the Township of South Stormont enter into a Boundary Roads Agreement with the Township of South Dundas for the purpose of exchange in road maintenance, winter maintenance, and garbage pick-up services in specified locations.
  - 2. The Mayor and Director of Corporate Services/Clerk are hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Township of South Stormont to execute the Agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this by-law.
  - 3. Any other by-laws inconsistent with this by-law are hereby repealed.
