## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH STORMONT

BY-LAW NO. 2021-001

<u>BEING</u> a by-law to authorize temporary borrowing.

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WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, c. 25 s. 5 (1) provides

that the powers of a municipal corporation are

to be exercised by its council;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, c. 25 s. 5 (3) provides

that the powers of every council are to be

exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, c.25, s. 407 provides

a municipality to authorize temporary borrowing, until the taxes are collected, and other revenues are received, of the amounts that the municipality considers necessary to meet the current expenses of the municipality

for the year;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Township of

South Stormont deems it necessary to prepare for temporary borrowing, the sum of nine million, fifty thousand dollars (\$9,050,000) to meet the current expenditures of the

Corporation for the year;

<u>AND WHEREAS</u> the amount of the estimated revenues of the

Corporation have not yet been adopted, and the amount of the estimated revenues of the Corporation as set forth in the estimates adopted for the preceding year is eighteen million, one hundred thousand dollars

(\$18,100,000);

AND WHEREAS the amount to be borrowed under this by-law

and the amount of borrowings that have been repaid does not, in the aggregate, exceed from January 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> of the year, 50% of the total, and from October 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 25% of the total of the estimated

revenues of the Corporation as set out above.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Township of South Stormont

of the Corporation are hereby authorized, on behalf of the Corporation, to authorize temporary borrowing from the Bank of Montreal, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate nine million, fifty thousand dollars (\$9,050,000.00) to meet, until the taxes are

Corporation for the year, including the

amounts required for the purposes mentioned in s. 407 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25 and to give to the Bank, on behalf of the Corporation, the monies so borrowed with interest at a rate not exceeding the prime rate per centum per annum, which may be paid in advance or otherwise.

- 2. All sums borrowed from the Bank of Montreal, for any or all of the purposes mentioned in s. 407 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Corporation for the current year and for all preceding years, as and when such revenues are received.
- 3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed pursuant to the authority by-law, as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and any previous years from the Bank of Montreal for any or all of the purposes mentioned in s. 407 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, c. 25, together with interest thereon, all monies hereafter collected or received on account of realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year and preceding years and all of the monies collected or received from any other source, which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.
- 4. That any by-law inconsistent with this by-law is hereby repealed.
