

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH STORMONT

BY-LAW No. 2021-097

BEING a by-law to amend By-law No. 2016-107 and to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the Township of South Stormont.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25 SS. 5 (1) provides that the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its council;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25 SS. 5 (3) provides that the powers of every council are to be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c.25 S. 227 outlines various roles for the officers and employees of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the *Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter P.15, s. 15 (1) provides that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the *Police Services Act R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter P.15, s. 15 (2) provides that Municipal Law Enforcement Officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Township of South Stormont did, on the 14th day of December, 2016, pass By-law No. 2016-107, being a by-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Township of South Stormont deems it expedient to amend By-law No. 2016-107 to update staff appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Township of South Stormont enacts as follows:

1. That By-law No. 2016-107, be amended by deleting Paragraphs 1 and 2 in their entirety and replacing them with the following:

“1. That effective December 14, 2016, Mark Zoppas be appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the Township of South Stormont, specifically for the enforcement of the Township’s current Parking Regulation By-law to carry out all statutory duties in accordance with the *Municipal Act, 2001* and any other acts that apply.

2. That effective December 14, 2016, Kris St. Thomas be appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the Township of South Stormont, specifically for the enforcement of the Township’s current Parking Regulation By-law to

carry out all statutory duties in accordance with the *Municipal Act, 2001* and any other acts that apply.

3. That effective December 15, 2021, Chris Bonneville be appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the Township of South Stormont, specifically for the enforcement of the Township’s current Parking Regulation By-law to carry out all statutory duties in accordance with the *Municipal Act, 2001* and any other acts that apply.”

2. Any by-law inconsistent with this by-law is hereby repealed.
